The amounts herein appropriated are intended to provide average compensation increases of ten percent for the period January 1, 1981, through June 30, 1981. The actual amount of increases paid to individual employees shall be determined by the director of the agency, department, or enterprise in accordance, where applicable, with central personnel division classification and compensation plans, except that a director of an agency, institution, or enterprise may grant increases which exceed the maximum limit of salary ranges in such plans. Compensation increases shall only be granted to employees who are currently employed by the state on the effective date of this Act and who were

employed by the state on July 1, 1980. The moneys herein appropriated shall be made available to the various executive branch agencies, institutions, and enterprises only after a determination by the director of the department of accounts and purchases that such amounts are necessary to pay the amounts of additional compensation in addition to the amounts provided in appropriation acts passed by the forty-sixth legislative assembly.
