The House convened at 9:00 a.m., with Speaker R. Anderson presiding.

The prayer was offered by Rev. Kerwin K. Sletto, Calvary Free Lutheran Church, Bismarck.

The roll was called and all members were present except Representatives R. Berg, Flaagan, Hausauer, Porter, Stofferahn, and Urlacher.

A quorum was declared by the Speaker.

ANNOUNCEMENT

 ${\sf SPEAKER~R.~ANDERSON~ANNOUNCED}$ that the House would stand at ease to receive the Senate.

JOINT SESSION

REP. KLOUBEC MOVED that a committee of two be appointed to escort Lt. Governor Omdahl to the rostrum, which motion prevailed.

SPEAKER R. ANDERSON APPOINTED Reps. Tollefson and Stofferahn to such committee and Lt. Governor Omdahl was escorted to the rostrum.

Lt. Governor Omdahl called on Senator Mushik as temporary chairman of the Legislative Council, to give her report. She also introduced John Olsrud, Director of the Legislative Council, to give his report.

John Olsrud introduced Chester E. Nelson, Jr., Legislative Budget Analyst and Auditor, who gave a report on the fiscal matters concerning the state.

MOTION

REP. KLOUBEC MOVED that a committee of two be appointed to escort Wayne Sanstead, Superintendent of Public Instruction, to the rostrum, which motion prevailed.

LT. GOVERNOR OMDAHL APPOINTED Reps. Kretschmar and DeMers to escort Wayne Sanstead, Superintendent of Public Instruction, to the rostrum. Superintendent Sanstead reported on the status of school district restructuring planning grants.

MOTION

 $\mbox{REP.}$ KLOUBEC \mbox{MOVED} that the Joint Session stand in recess for fifteen minutes, which motion prevailed.

The Joint Session reconvened pursuant to recess taken with Lt. Governor Omdahl presiding.

LT. GOVERNOR OMDAHL APPOINTED Reps. Carlson and Wentz to escort Thomas Clifford, Chancellor of Higher Education, to the rostrum to give a report on the seven-year plan for the system of higher education.

MOTION

REP. KLOUBEC MOVED that the Joint Session of the House and Senate of the Fifty-second Legislative Assembly be dissolved, which motion prevailed.

The Joint Session was declared dissolved by the President of the Senate, Lt. Governor Omdahl.
