FIRST READING OF SENATE BILLS

Sens. Thane, Tallackson, Nelson and Reps. Nicholas, Miller, Nowatzki introduced:

SB 2282: A BILL for an Act to provide for a North Dakota corn utilization council; to provide for an assessment on corn production; to provide a penalty; and to provide a continuing appropriation.

Was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

Sen. Tallackson and Reps. D. Olsen, Aarsvold introduced:

SB 2283: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 61-04-06.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to priority of water rights. Was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.

Sen. Tallackson and Reps. Skjerven, Gorder introduced:

SB 2284: A BILL for an Act to authorize the director of the department of human services to transfer title and convey certain land at the state developmental center at Grafton to the city of Grafton.

Was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

Sens. Marks, O'Connell and Rep. Bernstein introduced:

SB 2288: A BILL for an Act to require buying clubs to be bonded; and to provide a penalty.

Was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Sen. Peterson and Rep. Soukup introduced:

SB 2289: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 8-02-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the degree of care required by gratuitous carriers.

Was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Sen. Traynor introduced:
SB 2291: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 31-04-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to affidavits of publication. Was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
