Each early childhood facility shall pay the fees thirty days after the close of each calendar quarter and the department shall deposit the moneys in a special account in the state treasury. Moneys in the account may be spent only for matching federal funds for child care services reimbursements paid by the

department under child care assistance programs. For good cause, the department may extend the time within which a facility is required to pay the fee. Within the limits of federal regulations, the department may withhold the fee from payments made to early childhood facilities in lieu of the facilities paying the fee to the department. The fee provided by this section is imposed only when the funds collected under this section may be used to match federal funds and the department directly reimburses early childhood facilities monthly under child care assistance programs administered by the department."
