SB 2253: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 11-04-04 and 11-04-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to petitions and elections for the removal of a county seat; and to repeal section 11-04-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to removal of county seats not located on a railroad or interstate river.

Was read the first time and referred to the Political Subdivisions Committee.

Sens. Yockim, DeMers, Mathern, Thane and Reps. Gulleson, Price introduced: SB 2254: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-32 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the sentencing of sexual offenders; and to provide a penalty.

Was read the first time and referred to the Judiciary Committee.

Sens. Langley, Bowman, Solberg and Rep. Nicholas introduced:

SB 2255: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 36-15-21 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to brucellosis vaccinations.

Was read the first time and referred to the Agriculture Committee.

Sens. Mathern, Holmberg, Traynor and Reps. Lloyd, Kelsch, Delmore introduced: SB 2256: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the taking of fur-bearing animals.

Was read the first time and referred to the Natural Resources Committee.

Sens. St. Aubyn, Grindberg and Reps. Delmore, Nottestad introduced:

SB 2257: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-44.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to establishment of a college student intern program for executive branch agencies.

Was read the first time and referred to the Government and Veterans Affairs Committee.

HB 1023: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-35-02.6 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the duties of the administrative rules committee.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Government and Veterans Affairs** Committee.

- HB 1024: A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 28-32 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to environmental rules adopted from federal guidelines.
- Was read the first time and referred to the Natural Resources Committee.
- HB 1030: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 50-06-14.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to basic care facility rates.
 Was read the first time and referred to the Human Services Committee.
- HB 1056: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 25-04-17 and 50-06.3-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the timing of reports by the department of human services on the reduction or writeoff of accounts receivable.
- Was read the first time and referred to the Human Services Committee.
- HB 1117: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to authorizing the attorney general to enter into agreements for criminal history record and identification purposes.
- Was read the first time and referred to the Judiciary Committee.
