## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 17 of section 20.1-02-05 of the North Dakota
  Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 Subject to chapter 28-32, adopt rules for the licensing of guides or outfitters and 17. 7 may require records and reports as the director determines necessary. The 8 director shall require each guide and outfitter to provide an annual report of the 9 names and addresses of that guide's or outfitter's clients for the preceding year. 10 Reported names and addresses are confidential and are not public records subject 11 to section 44-04-18 and section 6 of article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota. 12 Upon request, the director shall disclose the names and addresses to a state or 13 federal agency for tax enforcement purposes. The director may, after due hearing 14 as provided in chapter 28-32, revoke or refuse to renew the license of a person
- 15 who violates the rules or fails to provide the records and reports.
