- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 9 of section 54-52-17 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a default retirement benefit for national guard security officers and
- 3 firefighters under the public employees retirement system.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 9 of section 54-52-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 9. The board shall adopt rules providing for the receipt of retirement benefits in the following optional forms:
 - a. Single life.
 - b. An actuarially equivalent joint and survivor option, with fifty percent or one hundred percent options.
 - c. An actuarially equivalent level social security option, which is available only to members who retire prior to attaining the age at which they may begin to receive unreduced social security benefits.
 - d. Life with five-year or ten-year certain options.

Except for supreme and district court judges and national guard security officers and firefighters, unless a member specifically requests that the member receive benefits according to one of these options at the time of applying for retirement, all retirement benefits must be in the form of a single life benefit. For supreme and district court judges, unless a member specifically requests that the member receive benefits according to one of these options at the time of applying for retirement, all retirement benefits must be in the form of a lifetime monthly pension with fifty percent of the benefit continuing for the life of the surviving spouse, if any. For national guard security officers and firefighters, unless a member specifically
