3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-21-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **15.1-21-02. High schools Required units.** In order to be approved by the superintendent of public instruction, each public and nonpublic high school shall make available to each student during each school year at least:
- Four <u>separate grade-level</u> units of English, <u>each of which must emphasize</u>
 composition, grammar, literature, and speech.
- Three Four separate grade-level units of mathematics, including algebra, plane
 geometry, intermediate algebra, and trigonometry.
- 3. Four <u>separate grade-level</u> units of science, <u>including chemistry</u>, <u>biology</u>, <u>and</u>
 physics.
- 4. Three Four separate grade-level units of social studies, including one of world
 history and one of, United States history, both of which must emphasize and
 geography.
- 5. One unit Two separate grade-level units of health and physical education.
- One unit Two separate grade-level units of instrumental music or two separate
 grade-level units of choral music.
- 7. Three separate grade-level units of the same foreign language.
- 22 <u>8. Any six Six elective</u> units <u>applicable to each grade level</u> selected from business 23 education, economics and the free enterprise system, foreign language, American 24 sign language, and vocational courses, including family and consumer sciences,

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1	agriculture, business and office technology, marketing, diversified occupations,
2	trade and industrial education, technology education, and health careers. The
3	vocational courses may be offered through cooperative arrangements approved by
4	the state board for vocational and technical education.
