2		least one representative of an employer who is in the negative employer rate
3		group and may include the names of individuals who are not members of the
4		greater North Dakota association.
5		b. Three members who represent employees must be initially appointed from a
6		list of seven names submitted by the North Dakota American federation of
7		labor-congress of industrial organizations. Of the members first appointed,
8		one member shall serve a term of one year, one member shall serve a term of
9		two years, and one member shall serve a term of three years. Thereafter, the
10		term of office of each member is three years. The North Dakota American
11		federation of labor-congress of industrial organizations shall submit a list of
12		three names to the governor by August first of each year and the governor
13		shall appoint a member to the council within thirty days after August first.
14		c. One member who must be a resident of the state and who shall serve as the
15		chairman of the council must be appointed for a three-year term of office.
16	<u>2.</u>	A vacancy on the council may be filled by the governor from a list of names
17		previously submitted by the entity that the member represented or from a new list
18		of names solicited by the governor from that entity.
19	<u>3.</u>	The unemployment insurance advisory council shall advise job service North
20		Dakota regarding issues relating to the operations, effectiveness, fairness, and
21		efficiency of the unemployment insurance program, and on such related issues or
22		concerns brought to the council's attention by the executive director or the
23		executive director's designee. The council shall meet at the call of the chairman or
24		at the call of the executive director.
25	<u>4.</u>	The state members of the unemployment insurance advisory council must be
26		reimbursed for any necessary expenses but shall serve without further and are
27		entitled to receive compensation except such as may be authorized and fixed by
28		the bureau by regulation. Local advisory councils may be reimbursed for any
29		necessary expenses but must serve without further compensation in the sum of
30		fifty dollars per day spent in attendance at meetings.
