13		(1)	The precise location and the number of acres [hectares] of the land
14			affected.
15		(2)	The permit and the date approved.
16		(3)	The amount of the bond filed and the portion sought to be released.
17		(4)	The type and approximate dates of reclamation work performed and a
18			description of the results achieved as they relate to the permittee's
19			approved reclamation plan.
20		(5)	The right to file written objections and to request a public hearing or an
21			informal conference as specified in subsection 2.

reclamation operations took place, notifying them of the permittee's intention
to seek release from the bond. Such The letters must also contain notice of
the right to file written objections and request an informal conference or a
public hearing as specified in subsection 2.
