- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-52.5 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to employee criminal history record investigation.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-52.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Employee criminal history record investigation Fingerprinting required. For an individual first employed by the retirement and investment office after July 31, 2005, the executive director of the office shall secure a complete set of fingerprints of that employee if
- that employee has unescorted physical access to the office or any security-sensitive area of the
  office as designated by the executive director. The executive director shall ensure that the
- 11 fingerprints are submitted to the bureau of criminal investigation for verification of the identity of
- 12 the employee and to obtain criminal history record information and to the federal bureau of
- 13 investigation for a nationwide background check. The bureau of criminal investigation shall
- 14 provide any criminal history record information that may lawfully be made available under
- 15 chapter 12-60 and the response of the federal bureau of investigation to the retirement and
- 16 investment office.
