## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## 4 SECTION 1. TECHNOLOGY COMMERCIALIZATION STUDY - REPORT TO 5

- **LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.** During the 2005-06 interim, the [department of commerce] [state
- 6 board of higher education] shall conduct a study of incentives the state could adopt to serve as
- 7 catalysts for stimulating more efficient commercialization of new technologies. The study must
- 8 include consideration of leveraging research, capital, and entrepreneurs; include consideration
- 9 of successful actions taken by other states to increase technology commercialization; and focus
- 10 on approaches that are specifically tailored to the state's unique circumstances. The
- 11 [department] [board] may contract with a third party to conduct the study. Before July 1, 2006,
- 12 the [commissioner of commerce] [chancellor of the North Dakota university system] shall report
- 13 to the legislative council the outcome of the study and identify proposed legislative changes
- 14 necessary to implement any recommendations to stimulate technology commercialization in this
- 15 state.
