- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 30.1-28 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the appointment of a successor guardian.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 30.1-28 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 created and enacted as follows:

 - Appointment of successor guardian.
- 7 1. If the appointment of a successor guardian is required, the current guardian or any 8 interested person may file a motion with the court for the appointment of a 9 successor guardian.
- 10 2. The motion and supporting documents must be served on the ward, the ward's 11 guardian ad litem, and every other interested person who has made an 12 appearance or requested notice of proceedings.
- 13 3. A notice of motion must accompany the motion and must include a statement that 14 provides an opportunity for hearing if requested in regard to the appointment of a 15 successor guardian. If a hearing is not requested, the court may appoint a 16 successor guardian.
- 17 4. If the current or former guardian serves or served as a public administrator or a 18 corporate guardian with more than ten wards, the motion and notice of motion may 19 be served by publishing the motion and notice of motion in a newspaper of general 20 circulation within the judicial district in the court that has jurisdiction is located. The 21 notice must identify all wards for whom the successor guardian would be 22 appointed. If a hearing is not requested by or on behalf of any of the wards listed 23 in the notice, the court may sign an order appointing a successor guardian for 24 those wards.
