CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT GRANTING THE RIGHT OF APPEAL TO THE DISTRICT COURT FROM THE DECISIONS OF JUDGES OF PROBATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

Section 1. That any person aggrieved by any decision of any Right of appeal judge of probate, within this territory, shall have the same probate judge. right to appeal to the district court as is allowed in cases before justices of the peace.
