#### CHAPTER 4.

AN ACT TO DISSOLVE THE MARRIAGE CONTRACT BETWEEN MATILDA IRWIN AND JOHN A. IRWIN.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

Section 1. That the marriage contract heretofore existing martida Irwin between Matilda Irwin and John A. Irwin be and the same is win divorced. hereby dissolved, and the said parties are hereby restored to all the rights and privileges of unmarried persons.

Sec. 2. That all property acquired and now owned by the Rights of parsaid Matilda Irwin be and the same is hereby declared exempt from any debts or liabilities of the said John A. Irwin, and the said John A. Irwin is forever barred from any alimony in and to said property, both real and personal, and the said Matilda Irwin shall have full power to sell any real estate now owned or hereafter acquired by her, and to make and execute deeds therefor, which shall be binding both in law and equity.

Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That the said Matilda to whom given. Irwin shall have full and exclusive control of her child, H. Irwin, begotten in wedlock, until he shall arrive at the age of majority.
