# CHANGE OF NAME.

### CHAPTER I.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF MILO K. LINEDOLPH.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

Section 1. That the name of Milo K. Linedolph, shall here change of name after be Milo Mills, by which name he shall be known in all intents and purposes.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage when to take and approval.

Approved, January 2, 1868.

#### CHAPTER II.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF GUNDER GUNDERSON.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dukota:

Section 1. That the name of Gunder Gunderson, shall hereafter be Julius Gunderson, by which name he shall be called and known in all legal intents and purposes. When to take

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.

# CITIZENSHIP.

### CHAPTER III.

AN ACT TO CONFER THE RIGHTS OF CITIZENSHIP ON JOHN, CHARLES AND ALEXANDER CORDIER, MINOR CHILDREN OF J. VICTOR CORDIER.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

When to become

Section 1. That John Cordier, aged seventeen years; Charles Cordier, aged fifteen years; and Alexander Cordier, aged eight years, minor children of J. Victor Cordier be, and are hereby created citizens of this Territory, on their respectively arriving at the age of twenty one years, with all the rights and privileges of other citizens of this Territory.

When to take

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
