CHAPTER 23.

AN ACT FIXING THE TIME OF HOLDING THE TERMS OF THE SUPREME COURT.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

Section 1. That there shall be held one term of the supreme shall be heldcourt each year, at Yankton, on the third Tuesday of January, and shall continue as long as the business may require.

Sec. 2. Either party to any action that is now or may here. Mitter party after be pending in said court shall have the right to one con. continuance tinuance as of course upon application to said court.

Sec. 3. That chapter 34 of the laws of 1867-68, be, and Chapter 34, laws 1867-68 repealed the same is, hereby repealed.
