## IMMIGRATION.

## CHAPTER XXV.

An Act Establishing a Bureau of Immigration for the Territory of Dakota.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

Bureau of immigration created.

SECTION 1. That for the purposes of preparing and circulating information concerning the Territory of Dakota and inducing immigration thereto, there is hereby created a bureau of immigration which shall be under the control of the commissioner of immigration for the Territory of Dakota.

Duty of commissioner of immigration.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the commissioner of immigration, to keep a record of his official acts, and to exert himself faithfully to promote the interests of immigration to Dakota, and report to the legislature during the first week of each session, the result of his labors, together with such suggestions as he may deem proper.

Appropriation for contingent expenses of office of commissioner of immigration.

SEC. 3. That for the purposes of procuring postage stamps, stationery, printed circulars and such other materials as may be necessary for the use of the bureau, the commissioner of immigration shall be allowed to expend two hundred dollars annually, which shall be paid by the Territorial treasurer from any fund in the treasury, upon the warrant of the Territorial auditor.

- SEC. 4. That James S. Foster is hereby appointed commister appointed sioner of immigration for the Territory of Dakota, and shall commissioner hold his office for two years from the first Monday in January, 1871, or until his successor is elected and qualified.
- SEC. 5. That at each delegate election hereafter there shall when commissioner of immigration who shall hold his be elected. office for two years or until his successor is elected and qualified.
- SEC. 6. That all laws or parts of laws, or other acts in conflict with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
- SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and when. To take effect, after its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER XXVI.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR PUBLISHING AND CIR-CULATING INFORMATION CONCERNING THE TERRITORY OF DAKOTA, UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE BUREAU OF IMMI-GRATION.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

- SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred dollars annually priated octrbe and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of culate information about publishing and circulating documents, calculated to induce Dakota. immigration to the Territory of Dakota.
- SEC. 2. That the commissioner of immigration shall have Duty of comtnet disbursement of the same, and the Territorial auditor immigration shall audit the accounts of the bureau of immigration in the auditor. manner as other Territorial accounts are allowed.
- SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage When to take effect. and approval.
