CHAPTER XXXVI

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SURVEYING AND COUNTY SURVEYORS.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakola:

SECTION 1. That in all future surveys made by county surveyabali be used ors in the Territory of Dakota, the "surveyors mark," patenby all conary ted by Carl C. P. Meyer, December 21, 1869, shall be used by placing the same at all corners where any mark may be necessary: *Provided*, That the cost of each mark shall not exceed thirty cents, or the cost of the right to make and use the same shall not exceed two cents each, and can be had at the said price of thirty cents each, and shall be fire-proof.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and/approval.
