## COURTS IN YANKTON COUNTY.

## CHAPTER 5.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF SPECIAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN YANKTON COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

Time of holding special terms of district court held in Yankton county.

Section 1. That there shall be held each year special terms of the District Court, in and for Yankton county, as follows: On the first Mondays of January, March, May, July, September and November.

What issues may be tried at said terms.

SEC. 2. All issues of law or of fact not requiring the intervention of a jury, and all motions may be tried and heard at Proviso. either a special or general term: Provided, however, That nothing in this act contained shall interfere with the existing provisions of law, relating to the holding of general terms of the District Court, or to the hearing of motions or applications at chambers, nor with the authority of any Judge to appoint special terms additional to those herein provided, or

whenever in his judgment necessity may require.

Where held and how long to continue.

SEC. 3. Said special terms shall be held at the court room, in the city of Yankton, and continue as long as the business When to take may require.

effect.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
