CHAPTER 6.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF YANKTON COUNTY, TO BORROW MONEY IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

Authorized to borrow money Yankton, be, and are hereby authorized to borrow any amount of money not to exceed in any one year, over eight thousand dollars, and for a time not to exceed twelve months. Said money to be used only to meet the interest on the bonds voted by Yankton county, in aid of the Dakota Southern railroad, and for no other purpose, and to draw no higher interest than allowed by law in other cases.

Anthorized to issue warrants SEC. 2. It shall be lawful for the county commissioners to issue railroad interest warrants, drawing interest at the rate of (10) ten per cent. per annum, not to exceed eight thousand dollars in the agregate in any one year the same being receivable by the county treasurer, for railroad tax.

when to take—Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
