AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A TERM OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE COUNTY OF TURNER.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

SECTION 1. That there shall be one term, in each year, of the when term of district court, held in the county of Turner, in the second ju-in Turner coundicial district; that said court shall be held at the county seat of said county, and that said term shall commence on the first Monday of June, if the clerk of said court, sheriff, and probate judge of said county shall direct the same to be held, and not otherwise; notice of the term of the court to be given at least twenty days prior to the sitting of the same, in a newspaper of the county, if there be one; if not, then in some paper in the nearest or adjoining county.

- SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of said court to appoint a clerk court shall of said court in and for said county of Turner.
