## CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT to Amend Section 656, of the Civil Code, Territory of Dakota.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

§ 1. Before whom MADE.] That section 656 of the Civil Code of the Territory of Dakota, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

§ 656: The proof or acknowledgment of an instrument may be made in this Territory within the judicial district, county, subdivision or city, for which the officer was elected or appointed, before either:

- 1. A judge or clerk of a court of record; or
- 2. A mayor of a city; or
- 3. A register of deeds; or
- 4. A justice of the peace; or
- 5. A United States circuit or district court commissioner; or
- 6. A county clerk; or
- 7. A county auditor.
- § 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
