Distribution of Laws.

CHAP'SER 46.

AN ACT to Amend Section Four of Chapter Three of the Political Code as Amende i by Chapter 37 of the Session Laws of 1879.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

§ 1. Who entitled to copies of laws.] That section four of chapter 3 of the Political Code as amended by chapter 37 of the session laws of 1879, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: § 4. The following named officers of this Territory and of the counties therein and none other, shall be entitled to receive without cost one copy each of the printed volumes of the codes and session laws of Dakota, published or purchased by the Legislative Assembly of this l'erritory for distribution under the provisions of this act, to wit: The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Dakota, each Associate Justice of said Court, each Clerk of the District Court, the United States Attorney for Dakota, the United States Marshal for Dakota, the Governor of the Territory, the Secretary of the Territory, the Auditor, the Treasurer, the Superintendent of Public Instruction, each District Attorney, each Judge of the Probate Court, each Sheriff, each Register of Deeds, each County Clerk or County Auditor, each County Treasurer, each County Justice of the Peace, each Coroner, each County Suerintendent of Public Schools, each County Assessor, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, each Library Association or Historical Society organized for the benefit of the public in any county or town of this Territory. And to each member of the Legislative Assembly a copy of the laws enacted by the Asembly of which he was a member.

 \S 2. All acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

§ 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
