

Proposed Amendments to the Constitution.

PROHIBITING LOTTERIES.

Be it Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of North Dakota, the Senate concurring: That the following amendment to the Constitution of the State of North Dakota, providing that the Legislative Assembly shall have no power to authorize lotteries or gift enterprises for any purpose and shall pass laws to prohibit the sale of lottery or gift enterprise tickets shall be referred to the Legislative Assembly to be chosen at the next general election after the passage of this resolution, as provided in Article 15 of the Constitution of the State of North Dakota.

AMENDMENT.

The Legislative Assembly shall have no power to authorize lotteries or gift enterprises for any purpose and shall pass laws to prohibit the sale of lottery or gift enterprise tickets.

INSTITUTION FOR FEEBLE MINDED.

Be it Resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives Concurring:

§ 1. That the following amendment of subdivision 8 of Section 215 of Article 19 of the Constitution of the State of North Dakota, be referred to the next Legislative Assembly of this State to be by said Legislative Assembly submitted to the people of this State for adoption or rejection, in accordance with the provisions of Section 202 of Article 15 of the Constitution of the State of North Dakota.

§ 2. That subdivision "Eight" of Section 215 of the Constitution of the State of North Dakota be amended so as to read as follows:

Eight. A State Hospital for the Insane at the city of Jamestown in the county of Stutsman, and an Institution for the Feeble Minded at or near the city of Grafton in the county of Walsh; and the Legislative Assembly shall appropriate twenty thousand acres of the grant of land made by act of Congress aforesaid for "Other Educational and Charitable Institutions" to the benefit and for the endowment of said institutions in equal division of said land.
