## CHAPTER 67.

### CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR.

AN ACT Fixing the Time for the Commencement and Ending of the Fiscal Year for the State of North Dakota.

*Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:*

§ 1. BEGINNING AND END OF FISCAL YEAR.] The fiscal year for the State of North Dakota shall commence the first day of July and end on the 30th day of June of each year, and all reports required annually or biennially by any State officer shall be made to and include the 30th day of June preceding, and all accounts of said officers shall be closed and balanced to that date.

§ 2. APPROPRIATIONS—WHEN AVAILABLE.] All appropriations made for the maintenance of the State institutions or other purposes, by the Legislative Assembly, shall become available on the first day of July next succeeding their enactment, unless otherwise specially prescribed by law.

§ 3. REPEAL.] Chapter 196, Laws of 1890, is hereby expressly repealed.
