DIRECTORS' MEETINGS.

AN ACT Authorizing the Boards of Directors of Corporations to Hold Their Meetings at Any Place Within or Without the State of North Dakota.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Aesembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ I. DIRECTORS' MEETINGS.] The meetings of the boards of directors of any private corporation created and existing or which may hereafter be created under and by virtue of the laws of the Territory of Dakota, now State of North Dakota, having one or more directors, resident in this State, or having duly appointed an agent resident in this State upon whom service may be made, may be held at any place mentioned and provided in its by-laws either within or without the State.

§ 2. REPEAL.] All acts or parts of acts in conflict with the

provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

PRESERVATION OF CORONERS' RECORDS.

AN ACT to Amend Section 675, of Article 13, of Chapter 9, of the Compiled Laws of Dakota, Relating to Counties and County Officers and Providing for the Preservation of Coroners' Records.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ I. AMENDMENT.] That Section 675, of Article 13, of Chapter 9, of the Compiled Laws of 1887 be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
