ACT OF FEBRUARY 28, 1893, REPEALED.

AN ACT to Repeal An Act Approved February 28, 1893, Entitled "An Act for An Appropriation for the Erection of the North Dakota Reform School at Mandan, and for Incidental and Contingent Expenses for the Same."

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ I. REPEAL. That Chapter eleven of the laws enacted by the Third Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota, being an act entitled "An act for an appropriation for the erection of the North Dakota Reform School at Mandan, and for incidental and contingent expenses for the same," approved February 28, 1893, be and the same is hereby repealed.

§ 2. EMERGENCY.] Whereas, An emergency exists in this that it is necessary to stop the further expenditure of money under said act immediately, Therefore, This act shall take effect and be in

force from and after its passage and approval.

RUSSIAN CACTUS.

AN ACT to Provide for the Extermination of Russian Thistle and French Weed.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ I. RUSSIAN THISTLE AND FRENCH WEED DECLARED NUI-SANCES.] The noxious weed known as Russian thistle and French weed wherever found in the State of North Dakota, is hereby declared to be a public nuisance, and it is made the duty of every person or corporation owning, occupying, leasing or
