REGULATING THE FEES.

AN ACT to Amend Section 2079 of the Revised Codes of North Dakota, Regulating the Fees of Register of Deeds.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

- § 1. AMENDMENT. | That section 2079 of the Revised Codes of North Dakota be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
- § 2079. FEES.] The Register of Deeds shall charge and collect the following fees: .
- 1. For recording a deed, mortgage or other instrumeut, and indexing for the first four hundred words, seventy-five cents; for each additional folio, ten cents.
 - 2. Copy of record, for each ten words, one cent.
 - 3. Certificate and seal, twenty-five cents.
- 4. Making certified abstracts of title, for the first deed or transfer, one dollar, and for each additional deed or transfer, twenty-five cents.
- 5. Whenever any person presents an abstract to the register of deeds who made the same for continuation of such abstract, it shall be his duty to continue the same, and he shall be entitled to receive twenty-five cents for each new transfer, and twenty-five cents for his certificate thereto, and no more.
- 6. Entering satisfaction of mortgage or lien, twenty-five cents.
 - For discharging notice of lis pendens, twenty-five cents.
- 8. For recording marks and brands, each twenty-five cents. 9. For filing and indexing a chattel mortgage, or for filing
- and indexing a renewal of a chattel mortgage, twenty-five cents,
- but no fee shall be charged for releasing the same.

 10. For filing and indexing other instruments not herein specified, authorized by law to be filed, twenty-five cents.
- 11. For recording a final receipt from the receiver of any United States land office, fifty cents.
