VACANCIES IN CERTAIN CITY OFFICES.

AN ACT Relating to the Appointment of City Treasurer, Police Magistrate or City Justice of the Peace, in Case of Vacancy.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. VACANCIES. HOW FILLED.] Whenever a vacancy occurs in the office of city treasurer, police magistrate, or city justice of the peace, in any city in this state, the same shall be filled by an appointment made by the mayor, by and with the consent and approval of the city council, which appointee or appointees, shall qualify and hold their offices until their successors are elected at the next annual election, and have qualified and entered upon the discharge of their duties.

§ 2. REPEAL.] All acts or parts of acts in so far as they conflict with any of the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

§ 3. EMERGENCY.] Whereas, an emergency exists in this, that there is no power of appointment to fill vacancies herein contemplated, and that said offices might become vacant for a time, to the injury of the public, therefore, this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
