DISTRIBUTION OF BLUE BOOKS AMONG SCHOOLS.

AN ACT to Provide for the Distribution of Blue Books Among the District Schools of the State.

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

1. The secretary of state shall cause to be printed a sufficient number of blue books for free distribution among the district schools of the state in the manner herein provided.

2. It shall be the duty of the county superintendent of schools to certify to the secretary of state on the first day of March of each year in which the legislature is in session, or as soon thereafter as possible, the total number of district schools in his county, in the libraries of which one copy of the blue book shall be placed.

3. Upon receiving the certificate from the county superintendent provided in the preceding section the secretary of state shall consign a number of blue books to the county superintendent which shall be equal to the number of district schools certified as provided herein. The county superintendent shall upon receipt of such consignment distribute the same among district schools of his county, and it shall be his duty to see that each and every school within his jurisdiction is provided with a blue book as provided in this act.

4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
