

by himself or his agent, select from all other of his personal property not absolutely exempt, goods, chattels, merchandise, money or other personal property, not to exceed in the aggregate five hundred dollars in value, which is also exempt and must be chosen and appraised as hereinafter provided.

PAYMENT OF MONEYS INTO STATE TREASURY.

AN ACT Providing for the Payment of Fees Collected by the North Dakota Government Experiment Station, Into the State Treasury.

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. PAYMENT OF MONEYS INTO TREASURY.] All moneys received by the North Dakota Government Agricultural Experiment Station for the Registration of beverages or of other products, or for the inspection of the same or any other products, shall be paid into the state treasury at the end of each month.

§ 2. EMERGENCY.] An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
