INSTRUCTION OF JURY BY COUNTY JUSTICE

AN ACT to create and enact section 33-12-23.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, providing that county justices may instruct juries in criminal cases.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE
STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1.) Section 33-12-23.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is hereby created and enacted to read as follows:

33-12-23.1. WHEN COUNTY JUSTICE MAY INSTRUCT JURY.) The county justice, if he is licensed to practice law in this state, shall instruct the jury on the law applicable to the case in the manner provided in chapter 29-21.
