- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to prekindergarten through grade twelve education standards for

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Standards and curriculum - Theories on human behavior - Rulemaking authority.

- Beginning July 1, 2022, each school district and nonpublic school shall ensure the
 portions of its curriculum relating to fundamental theories on human behavior,
- including theories on age, gender, and race:
- 11 <u>a. Are aligned to the statewide prekindergarten through grade twelve education</u>
 12 <u>strategic vision and to the standards developed by the superintendent of public</u>
- 13 <u>instruction;</u>
- b. <u>Clearly delineate intrinsic human nature from learned moral and political values in accordance with standards developed by the superintendent of public instruction;</u>
- 16 <u>and</u>

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- 17 c. Are presented for the purpose of encouraging student discussion.
- 18 2. The superintendent of public instruction shall adopt rules to govern this section.
- SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective upon its filing with the secretary of state.
