A power limited electrician of record is an individual responsible to adhere to all laws and rules of the North Dakota wiring standards for the partnership, company, corporation, limited liability company, or association and has shown proof of liability insurance that the power limited electrician of record is covered by the organization. The power limited electrician of record is not allowed to work on other property other than property owned or leased by the organization.

- 3. A non-contracting power limited electrician is an individual responsible to adhere to all laws and rules of the North Dakota wiring standards. Power limited electrical work shall be done under the supervision of a contracting master, master of record or a contracting power limited or a power limited of record electrician.
