TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Board of Addiction Counseling Examiners will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code ARTICLE 4.5-01 at 9:00am on Tuesday, March 13, 2018, at the North Dakota State Capitol, 600 E Boulevard Ave, Bismarck, ND 58505. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to update the laws regarding practice of addiction counseling in the State of North Dakota. The proposed amendments address licensing requirements. The proposed rulemaking implements bill number 2033 enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning the supervision requirements for licensure. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
