**NOTICE OF INTENT TO
ADOPT AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES**

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Board for Nursing Home Administrators will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code chapter 55-02-01 at 9:00 a.m. Central Time on Monday, June 20, 2016 at 1900 North 11th Street, Bismarck North Dakota 58501. The purpose of the proposed amendments are to update and clarify the rules governing nursing home administrator licensure. The proposed amendments and repeal address clarification on the requirements for initial licensure, a state nursing home administrator exam and fees, continuing education requirements, and inactive license status. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the North Dakota State Board for Nursing Home Administrators, 1900 North 11th Street, Bismarck, North Dakota 58501. A copy of the proposed rules and/or a regulatory analysis may be requested by writing the above address or calling 701-222-4867. Written or oral comments on the proposed rules sent to the above address or telephone number and received by July 1, 2016 will be fully considered.
