

**FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT, AMEND AND
REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES**

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Board of Pharmacy will hold a public hearing to address a proposed new section, amendments to existing sections and repeal a section of N.D Admin. Code relating to the ND State Board of Pharmacy Practice Act at 10:00 AM on Thursday, September 19th, 2019, held in the Conference Room of the Board of Pharmacy Office – 1906 East Broadway Ave in Bismarck, ND. The proposed revisions include:

- 61-02-07.1-07 Pharmacy Technician Registration Requirements - creates administrative code based upon Senate Bill 2306 for a provisional registration for current members of the military or their spouses

- 61-03-01-04 Pharmacist Licensure Transfer - creates administrative code based upon Senate Bill 2306 for a provisional licensure for current members of the military or their spouses

- 61-04-08 Limited Prescriptive Practices - Repealed based on changes made by Senate Bill 2231

- 61-04-11 Administration of Medications and Immunizations – revised the standards and authorities based on changes made by House Bill 1498

The proposed amendments and new sections are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. **A copy of the proposed rules are available at www.nodakpharmacy.com** or may be obtained by writing the North Dakota State Board of Pharmacy, calling (701) 328-9535 or by email ndboph2@ndboard.pharmacy.
