## NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Administrative Code Sections 33-03-24.1-01 and 33-03-24.1-23 at 1:00 p.m. on January 7, 2020, at the State Capitol, North Dakota Department of Health, Judicial Wing, Conference Room 212 at 600 E Blvd Ave, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendments to the rules are to update the regulations related to end-of-life services in basic care consistent with legislation passed during the 2019 session. The proposed rules are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the Division of Health Facilities, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND 58505-0200. A copy of the proposed rules may be requested by writing at the above address or calling 701-328-2352. Written or oral comments on the proposed rules sent to the above address or telephone number and received by January 17, 2020 will be fully considered.
