NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND AND REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

**TAKE NOTICE** that the North Dakota Department of Health will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Administrative Code Sections 33-03-24.1-01(21) and (22) and 33-03-24.1-24 at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, July 6, 2017, in Room 212, Judicial Wing, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendments concern basic care facilities and add new definitions and a new section related to provision of optional Alzheimer's, dementia, special memory care, or traumatic brain injury facility or unit services. The rules will not impact the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the Health Resources Section, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND 58505-0200. A copy of the proposed amendments may be requested by writing the above address or calling 701-328-2352. Written or oral comments on the proposed rules sent to the above address or phone number and received by July 17, 2017 will be fully considered.
