The purpose of the proposed changes is to revise 67-08-01, Homeless Children Education, to align with federal statutes; to revise 67-11-14, Certificate of Completion for Paraprofessionals, to require paraprofessionals paid with Title I funds to be certified immediately upon hire; to revise 67-13-01-05, School District Cooperative Agreements, to align with changes made in HB 1125 by the 66th Legislative Assembly to North Dakota Century Code (NDCC) 15.1-27-16; to revise 67-21-01, School Lunch Program, 67-21-02, School Breakfast Program, 67-21-03, Special Milk Program, 67-21-04, Children and Adult Care Food Program, 67-21-05, Summer Food Service Program, 67-21-06, Food Distribution Program, 67-27-07, Food Distribution on Indian Reservations, and 67-21-08, Emergency Food Assistance Program, to align with federal statutes; to create 67-21-09, Commodity Supplemental Food Program, and 67-21-10, Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program, to align with federal statutes; to repeal 67-11-09, Early Childhood Special Education Teacher Credential, 67-11-10, Emotional Disturbance Teacher Credential, 67-11-11, Gifted and Talented Teacher Credential, 67-11-12, Physical Disabilities Teacher Credential, 67-11-13, Specific Learning Disabilities Teacher Credential, 67-11-16, Special Education Strategist Credential, 67-11-17, Mental Retardation Teacher Credential, 67-11-18, Credential Requirement for Teachers of the Visually Impaired, and 67-11-19, Credential Requirement for Teachers of Students Who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing, to reflect that these credentials are no longer issued by NDDPI; to create 67-11-03.4, Reading and Math Credentials, and 67-11-03.5, Title I Coordinator Credential, to implement changes made in SB 2265 by the 66th Legislative Assembly to North Dakota Century Code (NDCC) 15.1-02; and to revise 67-23-01; Comprehensive General Plan Requirements for Special Education Programs, to change the age cutoff dates in the definition of children with disabilities from September to August to align with school ages in NDCC 15.1-06-01. The proposed rules are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
