FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO
CREATE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES
67-19-03 Innovative Education Program

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction (NDDPI) will hold a public hearing to address proposed new N.D. Admin. Code 67-19-03 at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, September 29, 2017, in the Peace Garden Room, Ground Floor, ND State Capitol, 600 E. Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND 58505-0440. The purpose of the proposed new rule is to implement certain provisions of North Dakota Century Code (NDCC) 15.1-06-08.2 and NDCC 15.1-06-08.1. The proposed rulemaking implements the provisions of Senate Bill 2186, enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning the creation of an Innovative Education Program. The proposed rules provide guidelines to schools participating in an Innovative Education Program to improve the delivery of education, to improve the administration of education, to provide increased educational opportunity for students and to improve the academic success of students. The proposed rule is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the NDDPI, Office of School Approval & Opportunity, ND State Capitol, 600 E. Boulevard Ave, Bismarck, ND, 58505-0440. Written or oral comments on the proposed rules sent to the above address or telephone number and received by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, October 16, 2017, will be fully considered.
