NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Education Standards and Practices Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code N.D. Admin. Code 67.1-01-01, 67.1-02-01, 67.1-02-02, 67.1-02-03, 67.1-02-03, 67.1-02-04, 67.1-02-05, 67.1-02-06, 67.1-03-01, 67.1-04-03 at 3:00 P.M. on Wednesday, February 12, at 2718 Gateway Avenue, Suite 204, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendments, is to amend the rules for Senate Bill 2306, passed in the 2019 Legislative Session, and to amend the rules to reflect additional board changes.

The proposed amendments address kindergarten through grade 12 fee configuration, military spouse fee waiver, alternate access license dates, school psychologist intern requirements, out of field endorsement requirements, educator ethics, national board-certified teachers, and general edits for clarity.

The proposed rulemaking implements Senate Bill 2306 enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning military spouse licensure. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the Education Standards and Practices Board, 2718 Gateway Avenue, Suite 204, Bismarck, ND.
