NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Education Standards and Practices Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code N.D. Admin. Code Section 67.1-02-02-02; Section 67.1-02-02-04; Section 61.1-02-03-01; Section 67.1-02-03-02; Section 67.1-02-03-04; Section 67.1-02-03-06; Section 61.1-02-03-07; Section 67.1-02-03-09; Section 67.1-02-03-10; Section 67.1-02-03-11; Section 61.1-02-03-12; Section 67.1-02-04-02; Section 67.1-02-06-01; Section 67.1-02-06-02 at 3:00 P.M. on Wednesday, November 8, at 2718 Gateway Avenue, Suite 204, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendment, is to amend the rules for House Bill 1098, passed in the 2017 Legislative Session.

The proposed amendment addresses kindergarten through grade 12 licensure configuration, major and minor requirements, alternate access license requirements, and substitute teacher license requirements.

The proposed rulemaking implements House Bill 1098 enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning teacher licensure. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the Education Standards and Practices Board, 2718 Gateway Avenue, Suite 204, Bismarck, ND.
