**NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

The hearing will be held at 2:00 p.m., central time, on April 30, 2015, in Room AV 212 of the State Health Department, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Judicial Wing, State Capitol, Bismarck, North Dakota.


The purpose of the rule is to right-size reserves by requiring insurance companies to adjust reserves upward in accordance with the new mortality tables that reflect consumers living longer lives.

The proposed rule may have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rule may be reviewed at the North Dakota Insurance Department, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Dept. 401, Bismarck, ND 58505. Written or oral comments on the proposed amendments sent to the above address and received by May 11, 2015, will be fully considered.
