
Dear Ms. Richter:

The Notice of Intent to Amend Administrative Rules and a copy of the proposed rules related to Article 10-16 (Multi-State Lottery) of the N.D.A.C. are enclosed as required by N.D.C.C. § 28-32-10(1).

The proposed amendments addressing changes to the General Rules definitions and restrictions, requirements, and authorizations; Retailer sales commission and bonus; Conduct and Play ineligible player and subscription; 2By2® Game Tuesday draw double prize feature; North Dakota Lottery Players ClubSM Points for Prizes® general, eligibility for points, registration, points for prizes points, submitting tickets, item selection, and additional conditions; North Dakota Lottery Players ClubSM Points for Drawings™ general, eligibility, submitting entries into points for drawings, and additional conditions are emergency rules with declared effective date as interim final rules of May 14, 2018.

The emergency rules are necessary to update the rules related to the method used to sell a ticket, changing subscription to Pick and Click online play, and replacing the trademark symbol SM with ® to identify registered ownership of the North Dakota Lottery Players Club. N.D.C.C § 53-12.1-13 allows the North Dakota Lottery to adopt emergency rules as necessary without the grounds otherwise required under N.D.C.C § 28-32-03.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Office of Attorney General will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to North Dakota Administrative Code article 10-16 related to the multi-state lottery at 9:00 a.m. CT on Friday, June 15, 2018, at the North Dakota Lottery office, 1050 East Interstate Avenue - Suite 200, in Bismarck. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to update rules. The proposed amendments addressing changes to the General Rules definitions and restrictions, requirements, and authorizations; Retailer sales commission and bonus; Conduct and Play ineligible player and subscription; 2By2® Game Tuesday draw double prize feature; North Dakota Lottery Players ClubSM Points for Prizes® general, eligibility for points, registration, points for prizes points, submitting tickets, item selection, and additional conditions; North Dakota Lottery Players ClubSM Points for Drawings™ general, eligibility, submitting entries into points for drawings, and additional conditions are emergency rules with declared effective date as interim final rules of May 14, 2018. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
