NOTICE OF INTENT TO
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Board of Massage will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code title 49 at 3:00 PM CST on January 3, 2018, at the Board's office located at 2900 E. Broadway Avenue, Ste. 2, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to clarify and update the laws regarding massage therapy practice. The proposed amendments address licensing standards and continuing education. The proposed rulemaking implements bill number 2092, enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning massage therapy licensure. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the Board's office at 2900 E. Broadway Avenue, Ste. 2, Bismarck, ND 58502-3141.
