

NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES  
RELATING TO NDCC 43-62 MEDICAL IMAGING AND RADIATION THERAPY

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Medical Imaging & Radiation Therapy Board will hold a public hearing to address adoption of North Dakota Administrative Code Title 114. The hearing will be held:

**November 9, 2017 at 10:00 AM in the Peace Garden Room** at the North Dakota State Capitol,  
South Entrance, 600 East Boulevard Ave, Bismarck, ND.

The proposed rules are North Dakota Administrative Code Title 114, North Dakota Medical Imaging & Radiation Therapy Board and include the following:

- **Article 114-01 General Administration**
- **Article 114-02 License Requirements**
- **Article 114-03 Disciplinary Process**
- **Article 114-04 Standards of Practice**

The purpose of the adoption of the rules is to implement Title 114 as required by the passage of Chapter 43-62 Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy practice act. The proposed rules will have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. No taking of real property is involved in this rulemaking action.
