NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Peace Officer's Standards and Training Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed new N.D. Admin. Code 109-02-06 and amended N.D. Admin. Code 109-02-01 at 1000 a.m. on March 29, 2018, at the North Dakota Law Enforcement Training Academy, 1320 Schafer Street, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed rule is to implement statutes which address the use of confidential informants by law enforcement. The proposed rulemaking implements bill number 1221, enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning the use of confidential informants by law enforcement. The proposed rule is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
