NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

Take notice that the North Dakota Public Employees Retirement System will hold a public hearing to address proposed new rules and amendments to Title 71 of the North Dakota Administrative Code. The hearing will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, December 17, 2018, in the NDPERS Conference Room at 400 East Broadway, Suite 505, Bismarck, North Dakota. The proposed rule changes are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
